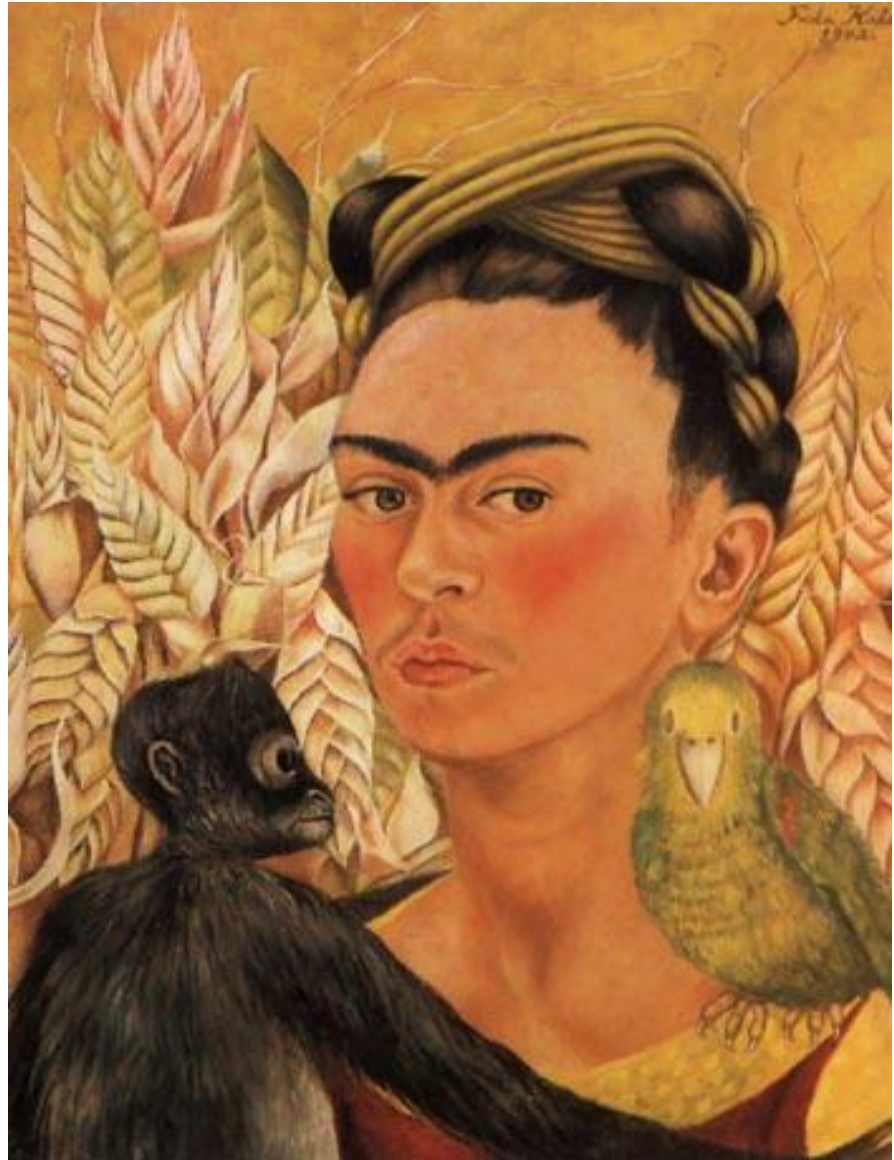

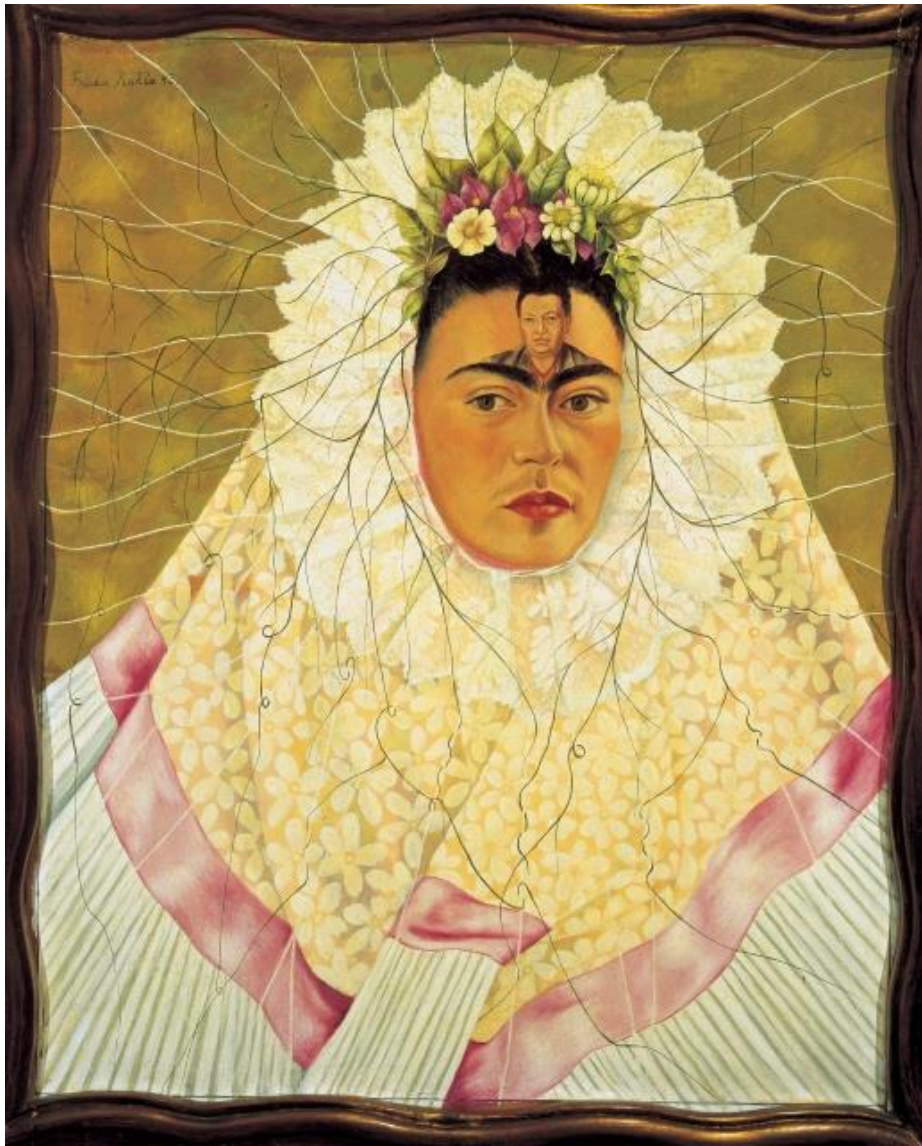


Self-Portrait with Monkey and Parrot, 1942



Frida Kahlo married a man named Diego Rivera.

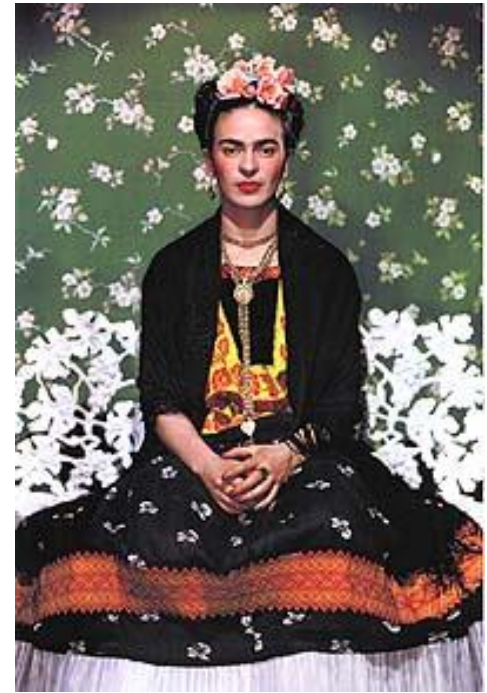
He was a famous mural painter also from Mexico.
